





### **LOCATION ANALYSIS**

## Site is within the path of development

- Located within the Los Angeles Unified School District
- Within 10 minutes drive-time to downtown Los Angeles.
- Within 5 minutes drive time to California State University, and the University of Southern California Health Sciences Campus.
- In close proximity to the Los Angeles General Medical Center, Keck Hospital of USC, the 10 Freeway and 5 Freeway, White Memorial Hospital, East Los Angeles College.
- Los Angeles Union Station located nearby, as well as several bus stations such as Union Station Patsaouras Bus Plaza, Marengo St & State St.
- Attractions such as Los Angeles State Historic Park, Dodger Stadium, Elysian Park, Monterey Park Golf Club, Eugene A. Obregón Park are nearby.
  - Additional things to do: Heritage Square Museum, The Broad (modern art), Angels Flight Railway, Bradbury Building (historical landmark), Downtown Los Angeles Art Walk, Cascades Park, Monterey Park Historical Museum, Citadel Outlets, The Commerce Casino & Hotel.
